#### **Benefits of Scholarship**

The successful candidates shall receive following benefits during training:

- 1. Monthly Stipend: Nu. 50,000;
- 2. Book allowance (annually): Nu. 12,500;
- 3. One time establishment allowance: Nu. 10,000;
- 4. Research grants with DSA of Nu. 350 per day for the duration of two months *(for Master's Degree)*;
- 5. To & fro air fare (only once);
- 6. Coverage of health insurance; and
- 7. Tuition Fees.

### Eligibility

- 1. Must have minimum of 55% in Degree; and
- 2. Should be BCSE-Select.

- c. Recommendation Letter or Statement from the School Principal stating that he/she is currently teaching the chosen course in Cl-XI or XII in case of Teachers applying for courses such as Economics, Physics, Chemistry or Mathematics; and
- d. A copy of updated (accurate) CV in the CSIS.

All the applicants are requested to kindly mention the year in which you have appeared the Bhutan Civil Service Examination (BCSE) on the first page of In-Service Training Form.

#### **Application Procedure and Deadline**

The application documents must be submitted to:

- 1. Respective Ministries/Agencies on or before 28th December, 2016; and
- 2. Ministries/Agencies to the RCSC on or before 7th January, 2017.

- 1. All applications should be reviewed and endorsed by the respective Ministries/agencies as per the terms and conditions specified in the announcement. If any discrepancies are found after the selection, respective agency shall be held accountable;
- 2. The shortlisted candidates will be asked to submit a copy of Curriculum Vitae in the prescribed format (download CV format) and the deadline will be announced during shortlist announcement.
- 3. Further, they will also have to make a 10-minutes powerpoint presentation during interview and the topics will be given during shortlist announcement.
- 4. The candidates are requested to kindly update your CV in the CSIS before submitting to the RCSC. Calculation of marks for rural posting and seniority will be based on your CV
