Further, the candidates are required to submit the following documents to Sangay Yeshi of HRD Division, RCSC at syeshi@rcsc.gov.bt without fail:

1. Curriculum Vitae (CV) in a prescribed format ([Download CV format](#)) (latest by 2:00 pm of 30th January, 2017) which is to be circulated among the panel members.

The candidates are also expected to bring the original merit certificates in the following areas:

- Leadership (Eg. Officiating more than one month, team leader, etc...)
- Voluntarism/Community service/Extracurricular activities
- Publication/Research (peer reviewed)
- Professional Recognition (task force member with evidence of completion of assignment)
- Civil Service Award

Note:

1. Marking for the above documents shall be considered only after entry into the Civil Service
2. For civil servants who got Bachelor degree qualification through in-service programme, their individual achievement shall be counted from the date of appointment after getting selected through BCSE.
