their home/office life (such as handing over of work, moving out of their house etc) until the confirmation of scholarship/admission is received from RCSC;

3. Based on past experience, for some courses, it takes more than a year to secure admission which is dependent on the admission requirement and candidate's academic record. Therefore, please accept the scholarship after proper consideration.
4. Withdrawal/cancellation of scholarship shall result to HR action once you accept the Interview selection result.
5. For Residency Program in Ophthalmology, selected candidates will need to get through the one-month observation course in Thailand to be eligible to pursue the Residency Program. If more than 2 candidates get selected for the observation course, admission for the remaining candidates will be processed for 2020 intake to ensure that service delivery is not hampered.
