NOTIFICATION

Subject: Removing/deleting subsection (e) of section 20.3.2.1 of the BCSR 2018 (eligibility of ERS for Constitutional Members)

As per section (4) of the Entitlement and Service Conditions Act for the Holders, Members and Commissioners of Constitutional Offices of Bhutan, 2010, a civil servant appointed as a member of the Constitutional office has to resign from the previous post with post service benefits.

However, with the amendment of the Entitlement and Service Conditions for the Holders, Members and Commissioners of Constitutional Offices of Bhutan Act (2021), the members of the constitutional offices are not required to resign from the civil service making the current subsection (e) of section 20.3.2.1 of the BCSR 2018 which states that the Members of Constitutional Offices are eligible for Early Retirement Scheme (ERS) redundant. Therefore, in line with this amendment, henceforth, subsection (e) of section 20.3.2.1 of the BCSR 2018 shall be removed/deleted.

This shall be effective from 22 August, 2022.
