Course duration:

- Master's degree (2-year curriculum)
- Doctoral degree (3-year curriculum)

Eligibility criteria

A. General

1. Civil Servants as per BCSR 2012;
2. RUB employee as per the eligibility criteria set by RUB;
3. Private/Corporate sector employees as per the provisions prescribed by the Department of Human Resources (DHR), MoLHR;

B. Sponsoring organization

1. Not a Thai citizen, nor of Thai Nationality
2. Excellent academic record
3. Meet qualifications of SIIT graduate programs admission (visit http://www.siit.tu.ac.th/graduate_introduction_en.htm)
4. Two strong recommendation letters (at least one letter must come from academic instructor/advisor)
5. Have good health and good conduct
6. Must not be a recipient of another type of scholarship

Condition to continue scholarship

- Maintain a cumulative GPA of not less than 3.25 with no "F", "U", or "W" grades
- Make good progress in his/her master thesis/doctoral dissertation and report his/her progress every semester
- Assist in the Institute's work for 30 hours per semester, primarily focused on laboratory supervision or tutoring courses for at least 6 hrs, and the rest will be examination proctoring duty
