**Swedish Institute Study Scholarships Programme (SISS) for Master Degree**

The Royal Civil Service Commission (RCSC) is pleased to announce the availability of Swedish Institute Study Scholarships Programme (SISS) to undergo one or two year Master's degree (academic 2016/2017) in Sweden.

**1. Scholarship covers:**

- Tuition fees of the Swedish University;
- Monthly stipend of SEK 9,000 to cover living expenses;
- One time travel grant of SEK 15,000; and
- Covers Insurance.

**2. Conditions for scholarships**

- Applicants must apply and be accepted to a Swedish University within a relevant master's programme;
- Applicants must have at least two years relevant work experiences;
- Applicants must be able to demonstrate leadership skills; and
- Applicants may not have lived more than two years in Sweden previously, or hold a degree from a Swedish University.

**3. General requirements (in addition to the above conditions)**

- Civil servants applying for the scholarship must ensure they fulfill all the relevant eligibility criteria prescribed in BCSR 2012;
- RUB employee as per the eligibility criteria set by RUB; and
- Private/Corporate sector employees as per the provisions prescribed by the Department of Human Resources (DHR), MoLHR.
