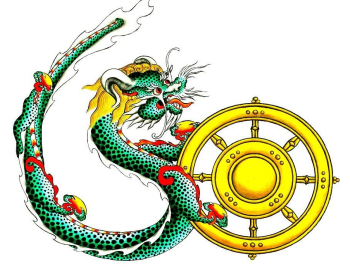

**2016 SAARC FRI Scholarship**

The Royal Civil Service Commission is pleased to announce that Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India is offering 10 scholarships to the SAARC Member States to pursue Master Degree of Science Courses for the academic year 2016-18 at the Forest Research Institute (Deemed) University, Uttarakhand (postal code: Dehradun 248 195), India.

The course is scheduled to begin from 1<sup>st</sup> week of July 2016 and would end by June 2018.

This year, the scholarships are offered for Master's Degree in the following areas:

- Forestry
- Environment Management
- Wood Science and Technology
- Cellulose and Paper Technology

Accommodation facility will be provided by the institute. However, food and other miscellaneous expenses must be borne by individuals.

**Eligibility Criteria**

1. Civil servants: must fulfill all relevant criteria prescribed in BCSR 2012
2. Pre-Service candidates: Must be BSc graduates with Biology/Forestry background
3. \*Others: as per the guideline prescribed by Ministry of Labor and Human Resources

- v. All Civil Society Organization

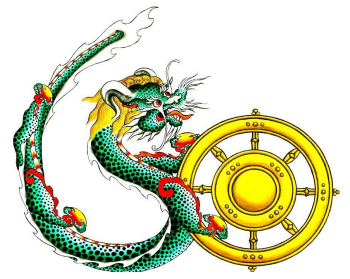

**Application procedure**

The application documents from:

1. Civil servants must submit to the Ministries/Agencies concerned for onward submission to HRD Division, RCSC;
2. Pre-service candidates must submit the application documents directly to HRD Division, RCSC; and
3. \*Others must submit to the DHR, MoLHR for onward submission to HRD Division, RCSC.

**Application deadline**

The interested and eligible applicants are requested to submit the application documents as early as possible (*no later than 14 May 2016*).
