	30	For 2 years	PERFORMANCE RATING
	10	Should have served at least 10 months in one particular place. Score based on Annexure 9/15 of BCSR 2012. <i>For example, if a civil servant has served for 4 years and 10 months in one particular place, s/he will get marks for 5 years.</i> <i>(Civil servants who got Bachelor through in-service programme, rural posting marks shall be counted from the date of appointment after getting selected through BCSE)</i>	RURAL POSTING
	10	Should have served at least 6 months. <i>For example, if a civil servant has served for 4 years and 7 months, s/he will get marks for 5 years.</i> <i>(Civil servants who got Bachelor through in-service programme, seniority marks shall be counted from the date of appointment after getting selected through BCSE)</i>	SENIORITY
	10	As per annexure 7/4 of BCSR 2012	RCSC-SELECT GRADUATE
	40	For applying for PhD: Master & Bachelor For applying for Master: Bachelor (60%) & Class XII (40%) Note: If the applicant is BCSE select and pursued PG Diploma marks will be taken in place of Class XII. So the PG D (60%) and Bachelor (40%)	ACADEMIC QUALIFICATION MARKS
