**Scholarship details**

The Colombo Plan Secretariat and KDI School of Public Policy & Management sponsors the following:

1. Admission process fees ;
2. Full tuition fees;
3. Housing; and
4. Living stipend.

However, following expenses need to be borne by the nominating member countries (nominating agency):

1. Book allowances;
2. Air fare; and
3. Other cost, if any
