Benefits of Scholarship

The successful candidates shall receive following benefits during training:

1. Monthly Stipend: Nu. 50,000;
2. Book allowance (**annually**): Nu. 12,500;
3. One time establishment allowance: Nu. 10,000;
4. Research grants with DSA of Nu. 350 per day for the duration of two months (**for Master's Degree**);
5. To & fro air fare (**only once**);
6. Coverage of health insurance; and
7. Tuition Fees.

Eligibility

Besides fulfilling those criteria prescribed in BCSR 2012, the applicants must also fulfill the following criteria in order to apply for the above scholarship:

1. Must have minimum of 55% in Degree; and

- c. Recommendation Letter or Statement from the School Principal stating that he/she is currently teaching the chosen course in CI-XI or XII in case of Teachers applying for courses such as Economics, Physics, Chemistry or Mathematics; and
- d. A copy of updated (**accurate**) CV in the CSIS.
