SIDA's International Training Programme (2018)

The Royal Civil Service Commission is pleased to announce the availability of Short Term Training on 'Intellectual Property for Least Developed Countries; Industrial Property and Technological Capacity Enhancement' under the Swedish International Development Cooperation Agency (SIDA) as detailed below.

A. Course Details

- The training will take place in The Swedish Patent and Registration Office in Stockholm, Sweden from April 8th-27th, 2018

B. General Requirement

The following criteria must be met apart from the criteria set by SIDA:

- Civil servants applying for the above mentioned programs must fulfill all relevant criteria prescribed in BCSR 2018.
- Applicants outside civil service (Corporate, and Private Sector, NGO, etc) must fulfil all relevant criteria prescribed Department of Human Resources, MoLHR Guideline.

Note: Please ensure (with Respective Agency or MoLHR (for private/corporate candidates) your eligibility before applying for the training.

C. Scholarship Coverage

- The Swedish International Development Cooperation Agency (SIDA) will cover all costs related to all programme phases except personal expenses, visa fees or any local airport taxes and departure fees

D. Application Procedure and Deadline

- Applications should be written on the special form attached and include a recent photograph and required information and documents
- Application in original with the required signatures and attachments should be submitted to the nearest Swedish Embassy/Consulate on or before **January 19, 2018**
