BCSE 2019 – Main Examination Result

The Royal Civil Service Commission would like to announce the result of the Bhutan Civil Service Examination (BCSE) 2019 - Main Examination.

A total of 1,748 graduates have appeared the Main Examination of the BCSE 2019. The graduates have completed their studies from 119 different colleges/institutes in eight countries. Besides graduates from colleges/institutes within the country, many of the graduates studied in India, a few completed from the region and two from the USA. 818 female and 930 male graduates appeared the Main Examination. There are 889 vacancies for 2020 intake in Professional and Management Category in the Civil Service.

All selected candidates are required to undergo mandatory drug test before their appointment into the Civil Service.

Yeshe Choden with B.A. (English) from Royal Thimphu College, Royal University of Bhutan topped the General Category with 80.71%. Chenpo with B.Sc. (Environmental Science) from Sherubtse College, Royal University of Bhutan came second with 71.56% and Tek Bahadur Ghaga with B.A. (Political Science), Sherubtse College, Royal University of Bhutan stood third with 71.54%.

Tashi Dorji who studied B.A. (Dzongkha & English) from Sherubtse College, Royal University of Bhutan topped the Dzongkha Category with 73.77% while Sangay Wangchuk with B.A. (Dzongkha & History) from Sherubtse College, Royal University of Bhutan came second with 71.74% and Tendrel Zangmo with B.A. (Language & Literature) from Institute of Language & Cultural Studies, Royal University of Bhutan stood third with 71.68%.

In Technical Category, Karma Chorten Dendup, B.Sc. (Forestry) graduate from College of Natural Resources, Royal University of Bhutan obtained highest score with 73.26% followed by Pema Wangdi, with 72% and Passang Dorji, with 71.31%, both with B.Sc. (Statistics) from Amity Institute of Applied Sciences, Uttar Pradesh, India.

Karma Thinley topped the B.Ed. Dzongkha Category with 69.5% while Leki Wangdi came second with 69.23% and Tandin Namgay stood third with 68.41%. B.Ed. Dzongkha course is offered in Paro College of Education, Royal University of Bhutan.
