Hubert H. Humphrey Fellowship 2021

The Royal Civil Service Commission is pleased to announce the availability of six (3 for regular Humphrey Fellowship Program and 3 under the Long-Term English (LTE) Training), non-degree Hubert H. Humphrey Fellowships for 2020-2021 academic year, awarded by the Government of the United States through the Cultural Affairs, American Center, U.S. Embassy in New Delhi.

The 3 nominees under the Long-Term English (LTE) language training opportunity is to facilitate the participation of candidates from non-elite populations, rural areas, minority groups and others who may be excellent candidates but lack the necessary English language skills. Selected LTE participants will be brought to the U.S. for an intensive 20-25 week pre academic program to improve their language skills before transitioning to their academic-year Humphrey campuses.

1. Prerequisites for the Fellowships:

- Be young mid-career professionals in leadership positions having a commitment to public service and the potential for professional advancement;
- Have a minimum of five years of full-time professional experience (prior to August 2020) in the relevant field, after completing a university degree, and should be interested in the policy aspects of their fields of specialization.
- Have completed a university degree program requiring at least four years of full time study to qualify for participation in U. S. graduate study programs;
- Be proficient in both written and spoken English (minimum TOEFL score of 525 paper-based or 71 internet-based); although scores lower than the above may be eligible for the Long-Term English program.

2. Ineligible candidates include:

- Candidates without a first university degree
- Those with less than five year of professional experience



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- University teachers or academic researchers with no management responsibilities (except for the specialists in the fields of Substance Abuse Education, Prevention, and Treatment and Teacher for Teaching of English as a Foreign Language)
- Individuals who have attended a graduate school in the United States for one academic year or more during the seven years prior to August 2020
- Individuals with other recent U.S. in-country experience of any kind lasting more than six months during the five years prior to August 2019.
