1. Benefits of the Scholarship

The Scholarship shall cover the following:

- Round trip airfare
- Tuition Fees
- Stipend
- Living Expenses
- Book Allowance
- Thesis grant (if any)
- Medical Insurance

2. Prerequisites of the University/Institute

a. Academic Qualifications (any one of the following)

Bachelor's degree in Civil/Agricultural Engineering/Hydrology or its equivalent qualification

b. Conditions for full time sponsored/nominated candidates only:

Candidates seeking admission to the M.Tech. programme in Hydrology and who possess the required qualification(s) stated above must have at least 60% aggregate marks or 6.00 CGPA on a 10 point scale at qualifying degree level.

3. Additional Requirements as per BCSR 2018

- Should have bachelor degree at the time of entry into civil service or be selected through BCSE;
- Should fulfil other eligibility criteria specified in Section 9.7.3 where applicable
- Clean service record; and
- Civil servants applying for the scholarship and the agency nominating the candidate must ensure the applicant fulfills all the relevant eligibility criteria prescribed in the BCSR 2018.

4. Scholarship application procedure

- Candidate checks eligibility as per the checklist ([click here](#)) and scholarship criteria
- If eligible, seek endorsement from the agency
- Agency checks the eligibility as per the checklist ([click here](#)) and scholarship criteria
- If endorsed by the agency, candidate applies for the scholarship online ([click here](#))
- Once an online scholarship application is completed, candidates must submit a hard copy of the online admission form to the RCSC through their respective agency in the given deadline.
- RCSC forwards the application documents to the Embassy of India, Thimphu through MoFA after checking the BCSR eligibility and scholarship criteria.
- The selection shall be done by IIT Roorkee, India upon receiving the application from other international students. Therefore, the number of slots available will be decided based on the number of applicants.

5. Deadlines related to scholarship

Announcement of the Scholarship	: 16th April, 2021
Deadline for Application	: 14th May, 2021
Online Application Period (in the given link above)	: 17th May- 1st June, 2021
Submission of hard copy of the online application to RCSC	: 4th June, 2021

Important notes:

- i. For further detailed information regarding the scholarship offer please refer to the Admission Brochure ([click here](#))
- ii. Confirmation of scholarship and date of commencement of course shall depend on the candidate getting selected for the scholarship. Therefore, the candidates are advised not to make major changes to their home/office life (such as handing over of work, moving out of their house etc) until the confirmation of scholarship/admission;
- iii. Nominations received without the endorsement of the agency will not be accepted.
- iv. Agencies should ensure that relevance of the course and only eligible candidates fulfilling requirements are forwarded to HRDD, RCSC on or before the deadline.
- v. Selected candidates shall also be required to take a drug test and will have to pass the test to be eligible for the scholarship.
- vi. For future career progression to Specialist position, Master course should be aligned to Super Structure.
