BCSE 2020 – Main Examination Result

The Royal Civil Service Commission is pleased to announce the result of the Bhutan Civil Service Examination (BCSE) 2020 - Main Examination.

A total of 2,400 graduates have appeared for the Main Examination of the BCSE 2020. The graduates have completed their studies from 126 different colleges/institutes based in 11 countries as follows:

There was an increase in both the number of female candidates from 818 graduates in 2019 to 1,238 graduates in 2020 and male candidates from 930 graduates in 2019 to 1,162 graduates in 2020 who have appeared for the Main Examination of the Bhutan Civil Service Examination. There are 843 vacancies for BCSE 2020 intake in the Civil Service at various positions of the Professional and Management Category.

Mindu Zam, B.Sc. (Food Technology) graduate from Mae Fah Luang University, Thailand topped the General category with 68.14%. Phuntsho Seldon Wangmo who completed B.A. (Honours) International Relations and Development from Khon Kaen University, Thailand came second with

67.88%, followed by Rinchen Choden with B.A. (Dzongkha & English) degree from Sherubtse College, Royal University of Bhutan in the third position with 67.10%.

Dorji Wangdra who completed B.A. (Honours) Language and Literature from College of Language & Cultural Studies, Royal University of Bhutan topped the Dzongkha category with 70.17% while Yeshe Lhamo who has also studied B.A. (Honours) Language and Literature from College of Language & Cultural Studies, Royal University of Bhutan came second with 70.02 %. Sherab Lhamo with B.A. (Buddhist Studies) from Institute of Science of Mind, Bhutan stood third with 69.32%.

In the Technical category, Ugyen Tshering, B.Tech. (Geo Informatics Engineering) graduate from University of Petroleum and Energy Studies, India obtained the highest score with 75.74% followed by Jigme Choden, B.Sc. (Statistics) graduate from Amity Institute of Applied Sciences, India with 75.41% and Leki Tshering, LLB (Honours) graduate from Kalinga Institute of Industrial Technology, India with 74.42%.

Rinzin Dema topped the B.Ed. Dzongkha category with 71.47% while Dorji Lhamo came second with 68.89% and Sonam Wangchuk stood third with 68.23%. B.Ed. Dzongkha course is offered in Paro College of Education, Royal University of Bhutan.

Jampel Pelzang, B.Ed. Primary graduate from Paro College of Education, Royal University of Bhutan topped the B.Ed. General category with 77.01% while Tenzin Yonten, B.Ed. (Honours) Special Needs Education from SEGi University, Malaysia came second with 75.27% and Kencho Tshering, B.Ed. Primary graduate from Paro College of Education, Royal University of Bhutan stood third with 73.73%.
