7.7 Conduct of Candidate (abstract from Chapter 7, BCSR 2018)

7.7.1 A candidate shall:

- 7.7.1.1 reach the examination centre at least 15 minutes before the scheduled time;
- 7.7.1.2 be in the national dress;
- 7.7.1.3 be allowed to enter the examination hall only on production of the e-Admission Card;
- 7.7.1.4 allow frisking/checking at the entry point of the hall or on re-entry after going out of the hall during the examination as well as after completing the examination;
- 7.7.1.5 not bring any article, electronic devices, documents or written material of any form inside the hall, except the Admission Card, pencil, sharpener, eraser and non-programmable calculator (fx 100 and below);
- 7.7.1.6 conform his behaviour to the civil service values and conduct prescribed under this Rule;
- 7.7.1.7 not be under the influence of intoxicants/alcohol in and around the examination premises;
- 7.7.1.8 not canvass for getting favour in the examination in any manner;
- 7.7.1.9 not talk, consult, whisper, smoke, eat or indulge in any unacceptable behaviour in the examination hall;
- 7.7.1.10 not carry electronic devices, including mobiles; and
- 7.7.1.11 not give or leave any identification marks on the written answer sheets other than the allotted registration number.

7.7.2 Non-compliance to the above rules shall result in debarring of the candidate from the present as well as future BCSE.

7.7.3 Any breach of rules during the examination by a candidate shall be reported in writing to the RCSC by the Chief Invigilator. Such candidate shall be liable for disciplinary/legal action by the RCSC.
