

Requirements for Viva Voce:

- 1. Candidates must come in formal dress with Kabney/Rachu.
- 2. Candidates must report on time. Please follow morning/afternoon schedule to avoid crowding at the viva voce venue.
- 3. Candidates shall be allowed to appear for the interview only upon production of the admission card.
- 4. Candidates are required to produce the certificate of merit (if any) in original and bring along a set of photo copies of the documents during the time of the viva voce.

Covid-19 safety protocols

Candidates are strictly required to adhere to the following Covid-19 safety protocols:

- 1. It is mandatory to put on a face mask by all the candidates;
- 2. Candidates must scan the 'Druk Trace' app while entering the viva voce centre;
- 3. Candidates must undergo body thermoscan at the entry point of the centre;
- 4. Candidates must wash hands before proceeding for the interview;
- 5. Physical distancing must be maintained at all times;
- 6. Candidates must maintain personal hygiene, follow coughing etiquettes, avoid frequently touched surfaces, not spit around, etc.;
- 7. Candidates are advised to leave the viva voce centre immediately on completion of the interview; and
- 8. Candidates are requested to support the implementation of the Covid-19 safety protocols at the viva voce entre and cooperate with the officials on duty.

Candidates who were given deadline extension till 18th November, 2021 to produce the original Degree transcripts are hereby reminded to note the deadline and submit the documents accordingly.
