**NOTIFICATION**

The Royal Civil Service Commission vide Notification No. RCSC/LS-63/NOTIFICATION/2019/2304 dated December 25 2019 introduced written assessment as the stage II shortlisting criteria for the selection of Director (EX3) through open-competitive selection.

In view of the feedback received from the applicants and experience from administering 19 written assessments, the Commission during the 116<sup>th</sup> and 118<sup>th</sup> Commission Meeting decided the following:

- Three (3) written assessments will be conducted in a year
- The results of the written assessment will be valid for one year
- Eligible candidates have the option to re-appear for written assessment only after six (6) months from the date of their last assessment.

These changes are being implemented to enhance the predictability and integrity of the written assessments and reduce administrative burden, and will be implemented with immediate effect.
