e) General Instruction

- Personal belongings, including mobile phones, EarPods, and Smartwatch shall **NOT** be allowed into the examination room. Therefore, candidates are requested not to bring such belongings. RCSC/invigilators shall not be responsible in the event of loss of such belongings.
- The candidates are required to bring along the original Admission Card (which was issued during the document verification).
- Viva Voce is scheduled from October 18 – 31, 2023. Information regarding the venue and schedule for the Viva Voce will be announced on October 8, 2023, on our website.

f) Selection and Placement

Selection and placement into the Civil Service shall be based on the following:

- a) Should obtain a minimum of 50% score in the Main Examination;
- b) Merit ranking of the Main Examination result;
- c) Availability of vacancy; and
- d) If there is a tie-rank in the Main Examination result for a vacant position, the Written Examination score shall be taken into consideration to break the tie and subsequently by the Viva Voce score in case there is a need to further break the tie of the Written Examination scores
