- a. Should be a Bhutanese;
- b. Should be 45 years or younger as of April 1, 2024;
- c. Should have bachelor's degree from the Universities recognized by the Royal Government of Bhutan and other countries;

- d. Should have a minimum of two years or more of experience under the same Parent Agency at the time of application to RCSC (such experiences shall be related to applying Sub-Program/Component);
- e. Should be a regular (permanent) government employee who is in Professional & Management Category (PMC);
- f. Belong to the service listed for each Component under the specified Super Structure Groups;
- g. Have a good command of both written and spoken English; and
- h. Should have sound mind and body.

1. Documents Required:

i. While submitting the documents to the RCSC:

- a. [Duly filled in LTT review checklist](#);
- b. Copy of system generated CV;
- c. Class XII Certificate and Mark sheet;
- d. Degree Certificate and Mark sheet;
- e. Merit certificates (Leadership, Volunteerism, Publication, and Professional Recognition- after entry into Civil Service)); and
- f. Research proposal (should be aligned to the agency’s needs and the applicants current job responsibilities and approved by the supervisor).

3. Information to the Candidates:

- a. Eligible candidates must fulfill the in-service training criteria of the BCSR 2018 (unless specified otherwise in the Scholarship Criteria);
- b. Applicants should consult respective Ministry/Agency before applying for the course;
- c. Applicants to kindly visit respective universities website for the availability of their research areas being offered or not ;
- d. Every qualified applicant will be required to take English proficiency test (IELTS) as well as math test in Thimphu. The fixed date and venue will be informed to each applicant.
 - **IELTS:** Refer to the link for sample questions to prepare yourself:

 - **Math test:** 60 minutes test consists of arithmetic operations, solving fractions, equations, inequality, matrix, basic quadratic functions, basic operations of exponential and logarithmic functions, basic integral and differentiation, etc.

Note: Applicants for Ritsumeikan University are exempted from math test based on the requirement from the universities.

*The scores will be reviewed in the first selection by the accepting universities. Universities may require the applicants to have good command of English (IELTS6.0 or higher) and numeracy skills.

5. Important Notes:

- a. Applications after the deadline shall not be accepted;
- b. Only those candidates who are committed to this scholarship should apply. If the candidate withdraws after the announcement of the interview/selection result, candidate shall be liable for HR action;
- c. Confirmation of scholarship and date of commencement of course shall depend on candidate fulfilling the admission criteria laid down by the University for securing admission. Therefore, the candidates are advised not to make major changes to their home/office life (such as handing over of work, moving out of their house etc) until the confirmation of scholarship/admission is received from RCSC;
- d. Agency should ensure that relevance of the course and only eligible candidates fulfilling requirements are forwarded to RCSC on or before the deadline. In the event any discrepancies are found after the selection, respective agency shall be held accountable.
- e. The scholarship is provided under the funding of JDS and all the scholarship entitlements are confined to those offered by them. No additional benefits from the RCSC/RGoB shall be admissible to the candidates under this scholarship.
- f. For future career progression to Specialist position, Master course should be aligned to Super Structure.
