KING'S SCHOLARSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT

The Royal Civil Service Commission is pleased to announce the availability of *King's Scholarship* slots for the academic session 2024-2025. As such, all class XII graduates of 2023 (not repeaters) from both within and outside the country meeting the eligibility criteria are encouraged to apply online via <u>https://www.citizenservices.gov.bt</u>, follow 'KS and UG scholarships (RCSC)' under 'Education & Learning' and choose appropriate application form. The application portal will be opened from 17 January to 31 January 2024.

The selection will consist of the following processes:

- 1. Psychometric test
- 2. Viva-voce

1. Psychometric test

The candidates who meet the following criteria will appear for the psychometric test, which will be coordinated by Jigme Singye Wangchuck School of Law (JSWSL):

I. Must score an aggregate of 81% or above in the BHSEC-2023 (60% in English and 70% in three relevant subjects as specified separately in the eligibility criteria above).

II. Must apply only in one field.

III. 30 candidates will be shortlisted in each field of study for a psychometric test.

IV. The candidates appearing for the psychometric test are required to pay Nu. 500 (Nu five hundred only) for administrative/logistic and other related costs (It can be paid to JSWSL).

V. Top ten candidates from each field based on psychometric score will sit for the selection interview (Viva-voce).

2. Viva voce

I. The ten candidates selected based on a psychometric test will attend the viva voce.

II. The selection of the candidates for the scholarship will be determined by the total scores obtained in the final interview (as per the interview format).
